

Customer battery take-back arrangement

Bombardier Transportation UK Ltd is a producer of industrial batteries (lead-acid, nickel-cadmium and other chemistries).

In order to fulfil our obligations under the Waste Batteries and Accumulators Regulations, Bombardier Transportation UK Ltd has implemented a customer battery take-back process.

As one of our customers, if you need to dispose of a battery in the conditions specified below, please contact your local Bombardier Representative who will initiate the internal battery take-back process, including free-of-charge collection and appropriate recycling / disposal by an Approved Battery Treatment Operator.

Conditions:

- *Only industrial batteries as defined under the Waste Batteries and Accumulators Regulations will be accepted. Bombardier has no legal obligation to accept portable batteries.*
- *We will not accept industrial batteries if we have not supplied your organisation with new industrial batteries during the current compliance year.*
- *If the industrial battery you need to dispose of was not supplied as part of a Bombardier rail vehicle, you need to speak to the original battery / equipment supplier first. We will only accept it if you can prove that you cannot return it to the original supplier.*
- *All chemistry types are currently accepted, including nickel-cadmium, lead-acid, etc.*
